PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE ~

As you can see in our school motto above, our desire is to develop strong learners with kind hearts. This month we celebrate Pink Shirt Anti-Bullying Day on February 26th. However, the reality is that we work hard to encourage and celebrate kindness every day. In a group as large as ours, conflict happens, and we teach our students what to do in those situations. Most conflict is not "bullying", but rather a reaction. But when nasty behavior is targeted and intended to cause hurt to others, it crosses the line into bullying. We work with our students to develop strong Personal and Social Responsibility skills so they can navigate conflict (ie. walk away, ignore it, talk it out, seek adult help) and know what to do if they feel bullied (ie. being assertive in telling the bully to stop, informing an adult). We will continue to do our part to support you as a parent as you develop strong learners with kind hearts.
