### **PARKING LOT SAFETY**

Thank you to everyone for your efforts in keeping the flow of traffic flowing smoothly. As we enter into Fall and Winter with poor weather conditions, this is even more important. Each lane of traffic has a purpose, and the image below should help clarify.

The green lines are for the "Thru Lane", which means no stopping in these areas.


The orange lines are for Pick up and Drop-off only, which means do not leave your vehicle unattended and be prepared to move if asked. The lower section is marked for Kindergarten Drop-Off, so please respect the fact that these younger students may need to be dropped off closer to the school for their safety. Thank you.


The **red lines** mean **no parking** and are **not to be used** for Pick-up or Drop-off (we do not want children running across traffic).


If you arrive and your child is not ready to be picked up, and you cannot find a marked parking place, please continue to drive around the loop until your child is ready. This keeps the flow moving.

#### **READ-A-THON:**

Our school wide Read-a—thon is on Friday October 30 from 8:50am—9:50am. This year our students will be staying in their classrooms to read for 60 minutes (grades 2 —



6) or 30 minutes (K-1). Primary students will do an abbreviated version of the readathon.

Last year we fundraised enough money to buy 5 brand new iPads, and a charging tub, for the library and makerspace. For the readathon this year we will be starting a 5year plan to improve the library. Our goal is to update our MAC computer lab in the library. Here at Promontory we are extremely lucky to have one of the only MAC labs in Chilliwack. Unfortunately, our current collection is becoming outdated and therefore obsolete. I would like to replace those computers with newer technology. Every year for the next 5 years I would like to purchase at least one or two new MAC computers. Ideally, we purchase laptops that can be used around the school when needed. The staggered purchasing will ensure our collection does not become obsolete all at once. This year our goal will be \$3 dollars from every student. The class that raises the most money will win a PIZZA PARTY!!!
