VANDALIZED BOOKS

We have a serious problem in our library and we need your help! There has been a large increase in vandalized books. What is a vandalized book? It is a book that has been deliberately destroyed by patrons picking the protective plastic and library stickers (barcode, spine labels) off of the book. When this happens, a book is pulled from circulation, and worst of all, it prevents other students from enjoying them. I have been trying hard to educate classes about this since September, but the problem persists.

If a book is returned to the library vandalized, the student must pay to replace it. Vandalized books will have to be reordered from a special supplier who prepares them for circulation. The supplier will prepare the books, cover them in protective plastic, and also apply any labels needed. After the new books arrive the damaged copy will be discarded.
