


## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

## **CAR LINE PROCEDURES**



Since early 2025, District staff have met with several schools including Promontory Heights to discuss ideas for balancing long-term enrolment and capacity in our schools.

In March 2025, District staff met with Promontory families to discuss a scenario to make Promontory Heights Community School a K-4 school with students transitioning to Stitó:s Lá:lém Totí:lt Elementary for Grade 5.

In June 2025, District staff informed Promontory PAC that there would be no changes for Grade 5 Promontory students in 2025/2026 or 2026/2027.

We are now following up to confirm that based on what we heard from Promontory families, the scenario of changing Promontory to a K-4 school will not proceed to public consultation.

We want to thank families for taking time to share their feedback.
